Goals of the Review Process

- 1. Implement a system of grading and reporting in M.S.A.D. No. 75, Pre-K to Graduation, that maximizes learning for all students.
- 2. Implement a report card that makes it clear and easy for students and parents/guardians to understand what a student has learned.
