

Free Decompression Utilities for the Mac: The Unarchiver and Stuffit Expander

1. Download Unarchiver or Stuffit Expander from Bookshare's website
 - a. Type Bookshare's URL into the browser: www.bookshare.org
 - b. Click on the **Help** tab.
 - c. Click on **Support Center & FAQs**. Click on **Find a Solution**. Click on **Downloading and Reading Books**.
 - d. Scroll down the page and click on the question: **What about Windows 98 PCs or Macs? Do I need additional software to unzip the books?**
 - e. Click the **Unarchiver** or **Stuffit Expander** link.
 - f. Download and install one of these utilities.

Bookshare says that Stuffit is not free, but there is a free version on Stuffit's website. Click on **Free Expander Download**. If you choose to download the free version, you will be asked to enter your first and last name and email address.

2. Set preferences in Unarchiver and Stuffit Expander
 - a. Unarchiver preferences:
 - Open the Unarchiver application.
 - Click the **Extraction** tab.
 - Extract archives to: **Ask for a destination folder**.
 - Create a new folder for the extracted files: **Always**.
 - b. Stuffit Expander preferences:
 - Open the Stuffit Expander application.
 - Select **Stuffit Expander/Preferences**.
 - Expand archives to: **Ask**.
 - Create surrounding folder: **Always**.
3. Open Bookshare DAISY files using Unarchiver or Stuffit Expander
 - a. Download a Bookshare DAISY file.
 - b. Open with: Select **The Unarchiver** (or **Stuffit Expander**). Click **OK**.
 - c. Navigate to a location (folder) on your hard drive where you want to extract the file.
 - d. Click **Extract** for Unarchiver. (Click **Open** for Stuffit Expander.)
 - e. If the book is copyrighted, supply the download password when asked.
